

Helps Ministry-Ushering

God hath set some in the church, first apostles, secondarily prophets, thirdly teachers, after that miracles, then gifts of healing, helps, governments, diversities of tongues.
I Corinthians 12:28

Ushering is one of the most important tasks in our church. It involves much more than the “passing of the bucket.” It includes assisting the pastor by greeting and seating visitors in the church, maintaining order, and receiving offerings. Ushers are empowered by the Holy Spirit to be the “behind the scenes people” who make sure that the church is running smoothly and efficiently.

Specific Tasks:

- Arrive 20 minutes before service to greet and assist any new visitors to their seats.
- Stay in the entry until after the Welcome/Greeting/Announcement part of the service to seat any late arrivals.
- Count the number of people in attendance and record this in the ushering notebook found in the bookcase in the hallway.
- Receive the offering. When the doxology is played, bring the offering to the front for a thanksgiving prayer. After prayer, place the offering in appropriately labeled bag inside the locking cash box. Lock the box.
- At the end of the service, collect the attendance sheets from the friendship registers and place them on Leslie’s desk. Straighten chairs, replace out-of-place hymnals or Bibles, and recycle any left behind bulletins.

Who can usher?

Anyone who feels called to this ministry may usher. This includes young children, with parent supervision, teens, or adults.
