Worship Leaders

Another important helps ministry in our church is the worship leader. Worship leaders assist the pastor by reading scripture from the Bible and help lead the congregation in prayer. They are essential in the deliverance of the message and in the sharing of the word of God.

Specific Tasks:

- Enter the sanctuary with Jay and sit with him in the front row through the first part of the service.
- Lead the congregation in the opening call to worship. Announce hymns.
- Read the scripture lesson out of the Bible found on the podium. Finish your reading with “This is the word of the Lord.”
- Lead the congregation in saying the Affirmation of Faith.
- Jay will let you know ahead of time what chapters and verses out of the Bible will be used so you can practice ahead of time, if you wish.

Who can be a worship leader?

Anyone who is a fluent reader may be a worship leader. This includes older pre-teens, teens and adults. Worship leaders may also work in “tag teams”; an adult is welcome to read one chapter in the Bible while their child reads another.
